THE PARISH CHURCH.—A Vestry meeting was held on April 13th for the purpose of considering the plans and specifications of Mr. Street, for the reseating and other alterations of the Parish Church, and for giving power to the Committee appointed at the vestry on October 14 1875 to apply to the Chancellor's Court at St. Asaph for a faculty for carrying out the recommendations contained in the plans of Mr Street. When these plans were approved, authority was given to apply to the ordinary for a faculty, and it was unanimously resolved that all the sittings be free and unappropriated.
